



2012 Chateau Buisson-Redon

Second Label of Chateau Mayne Vieil. The property dates back to the 16th century. The vineyards are planted with 70% Merlot and 30% Cabernet Franc. Bertrand Suze and his sister Christine own run the winery.

The Buisson Redon sees new and neutral oak and is made from a blend of 60% Merlot and 40% Cab Franc. 13.5% abv.

Chateau Buisson Redon is a vineyard in the AOC Bordeaux.

VINEYARD

High density vines are planted for high quality fruit. The harvesting yields are limited due to green harvesting in August and permanent grassing on the bed of the vines. The entire vineyard is pruned on one side to allow maximum sun exposure to the clusters in the morning while providing protection from the harsh PM sunlight of the afternoon. Chateau Buisson-Redon is the AOC BORDEAUX part of Château Mayne-Vieil; with an enclave in AOC Fronsac on several sides. It has a total area of 15 hectares (37 acres).

WINEMAKING

This wine is made in the traditional Bordelaise winemaking technique of three weeks of maceration in thermoregulated tanks to control fermentation. 20% of this blend is aged in new oak barrels for up to a year.
